4. Management and Responsibilities

- Matt Zhang will be responsible for: finance, client acquisition, and managing the studio.
- Anna Katrina Marchesi will be responsible for: design work, client communication, and project delivery.
- Major decisions, such as taking on new partners, will require the consent of both parties.

5. Banking and Financial Records
